These prices are effective as of January 1, 2024 but are subject to change without notice. The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff and Overhead.....\$2,995

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

This fee includes the following:

- >Personnel and facilities available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call or request for service.
- >Arrangement conference with family and/or responsible parties.
- >Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.
- >Clerical assistance in preparing and completing the death certificate.
- >Clerical assistance in preparing legal documents and authorizations.
- >Temporary shelter of the deceased person.
- >Coordinating with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition or transfer of the deceased person.
- >Preparation of necessary forms for governmental agencies.
- >Proportionate share of overhead expenses such as, but not limited to, facility maintenance, equipment, licensing, insurance, utilities, record keeping, property taxes, governmental compliance and administrative services.

Preparation of the Body

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Additional Services

Forwarding of Deceased to Another Funeral Home:..... \$3,495

This charge includes the transferring of the deceased from their place of death, basic services of the funeral director, staff, administrative staff, embalming, filing and securing of necessary authorization and transportation to local airport. Transportation beyond a 15-mile radius will be charged at \$3 per mile. This fee does not include any facility or staff usage for viewing or ceremony prior to forwarding of the deceased, or any casket or shipping unit.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home:..... \$2,995

This charge includes receiving the deceased and bringing him/her to our Funeral Center from the sending mortuary, temporary shelter of the deceased, staff services to coordinate disposition arrangements, transporting the deceased to a local cemetery or crematory and supervision of the disposition. This charge does not include any facility or staff presence for viewing or ceremony prior to the final disposition taking place.

Immediate Burial (Green Burial)..... \$2,995 to \$3,995

Our charge for immediate burial (without rites or ceremonies) includes our Basic Service Fee, transfer of deceased person to the Funeral Center, transportation of the deceased person to the cemetery, and customary services of funeral center personnel. Any casket provided by you must meet state and cemetery requirements.

>Immediate burial with casket provided by the purchaser.....	\$2,995
>Immediate burial with cloth-covered fiberboard casket.....	\$3,690

DIRECT CREMATION.....\$1,995 to \$5,495

Our charge for direct cremation (without rites or ceremonies) includes the transfer of the deceased person to the Funeral Center, Basic Services of the Funeral Center and staff, sheltering the deceased person, verification of identity of deceased person prior to cremation, transportation to the crematory, retrieving the cremated remains from the crematory, placement of cremated remains in the urn selected by the family. Any container for the deceased person provided by the purchaser must meet all state and crematory requirements. This charge does not include the use of staff or facilities for visitation, ceremony or reception or cash advances. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can choose:

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition material (with or without an outside covering.) Our minimum container is cardboard construction.

Payment Policy

To lose someone you love is one of the most emotionally challenging times in life. It can be overwhelming and can impair one's judgement. Therefore, it is important to be realistic with funeral expenditures. We want to assist you in planning the most meaningful celebration to honor your loved one's life while also keeping in mind your financial well-being after services are over. It is important that arrangements reflect your wishes within the budget you set forth.

We strive to serve every family as if it were our own. Our compassionate staff will work to meet your requests in planning a one-of-a-kind ceremony to highlight the life your loved one lived. Before you conclude conversations with our directors, they will discuss the following terms for payment with you and provide an itemized list of Goods and Services that you have selected. Funeral payment must be determined at the time of arrangements or prior to setting the funeral date.

We accept the following forms of payment:

>A fully funded pre-arranged funeral.

>Cash, Check, Money Order, or Credit Card.

>Life Insurance policies collected through Express Funeral Funding. Policies must be assigned to the funeral home. Any policy that is contestable will not be accepted as a viable payment method. Service information will not be determined until Life Insurance proceeds have been confirmed by the funeral home.

In cases where the deceased's estate must stand the burden of paying the funeral expenses, a family representative will be required to pay the funeral expenses and file claim for reimbursement with the loved one's estate.

At least one family representative and New England Funeral and Cremation Center must mutually agree upon financial responsibility. Please let us know which method of payment you prefer and if you have any questions.
